Milestones for the preparation of the Circular Economy Act

- ▶ Public consultation & call for evidence open from the 1st August until the 6th November 2025
- ▶ Environnement Council conclusions on the 16 December 2025
- ▶ Adoption expected for Q3 2026

Main conclusions of the public consultation

- ▶ Constraints - administrative burden and non harmonised rules
- ▶ Need of a critical volume of waste to be recycled in order to make viable business models
- ▶ The building industry is the biggest producer but it can also be the biggest beneficiary of a circular economy.

DG MARE initiatives for the Circular Economy Act

- ▶ Include the recycling of the composites and the end-of-life recreational boats into the Circular Economy Act.
- ▶ Establish synergies with the EU Ports Strategy and the EU Industrial Maritime Strategy
